DOG & CAT LICENSES



No residence shall have more than 5 dogs and/or cats, over the age of three months, within the City of Melville.

PET LICENSE FEES

- **\$20.00** intact dog or cat
- **\$10.00** neutered/spayed dog or cat
- **\$5.00** tag replacement

WHAT IS THE ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW?

The City of Melville places a high importance on the protection and safety of both animals and residents. In an effort to maintain and improve the quality of life and prosperity for our City; the Council adopted the Animal Control Bylaw.

PROTECT YOUR PET

Ensure you and your pet are safe by knowing and following the bylaw regulations. Owners are guilty of an offence if their animal is:

- Running at Large
- Unlicensed
- Bites or causes injury
- Defecates on private or public property
- Barks or howls excessively

LICENSE INFORMATION

All licenses are valid from January 1 through December 31 of each year.

When applying for a license, the applicant must provide the following information:

- description of dog or cat,
- name and address of owner,
- breed of dog or cat, and;
- certificate from veterinarian confirming animal has been spayed or neutered (if certificate can not be provided, owner must pay the unaltered fee of \$20.00)
